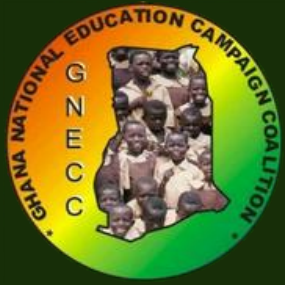

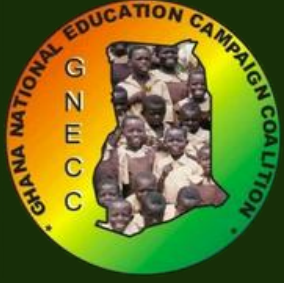
GNECC GAR'S MAIN GOAL

GNECC GAR's main goal is to promote quality pre-tertiary education for all children in Ghana with stakeholders at the national level, regional level, district level, and community-based stakeholders. GNECC GAR's mission is to work at changing attitudes and practices and influencing policies of institutions (local, national, and international, governments and intergovernmental bodies, donors) and the general public, towards ensuring quality pre-tertiary education for all.

In spite of the progress Ghana has made in improving access to education for all and improving the quality of teaching and learning, there are still challenges preventing thousands of children from going to school and learning. Children living with disabilities face even more challenges and adolescent girls are often denied the chance to complete secondary education.

GNECC GAR has a membership of 35 member and 10 individual members in the Region

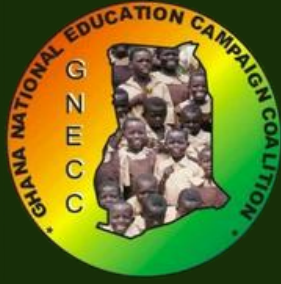




● DATA COLLECTION

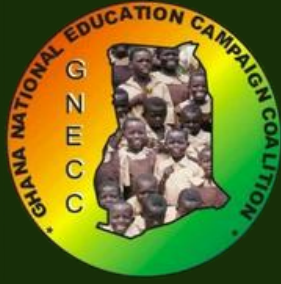


FIRST REGIONAL MEETING

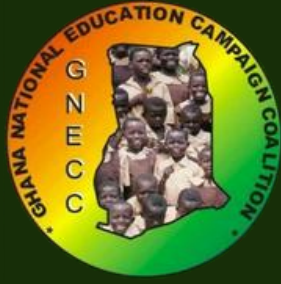
GNECC GAR had an emergency virtual meeting with members to discuss Global Action week and its activities. We had 9 members joining the Meeting on 17 April 2023.

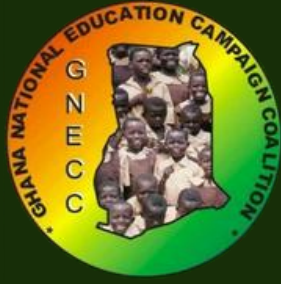

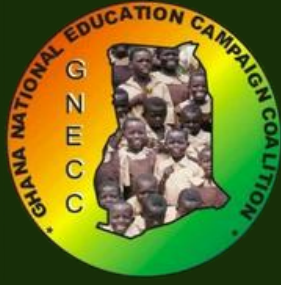




SECOND QUARTER REGIONAL MEETING

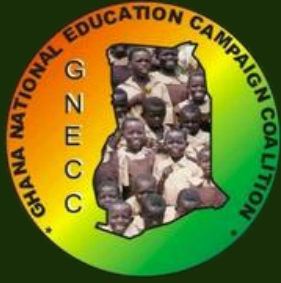


REGIONAL ACCOUNTABILITY DIALOGUE

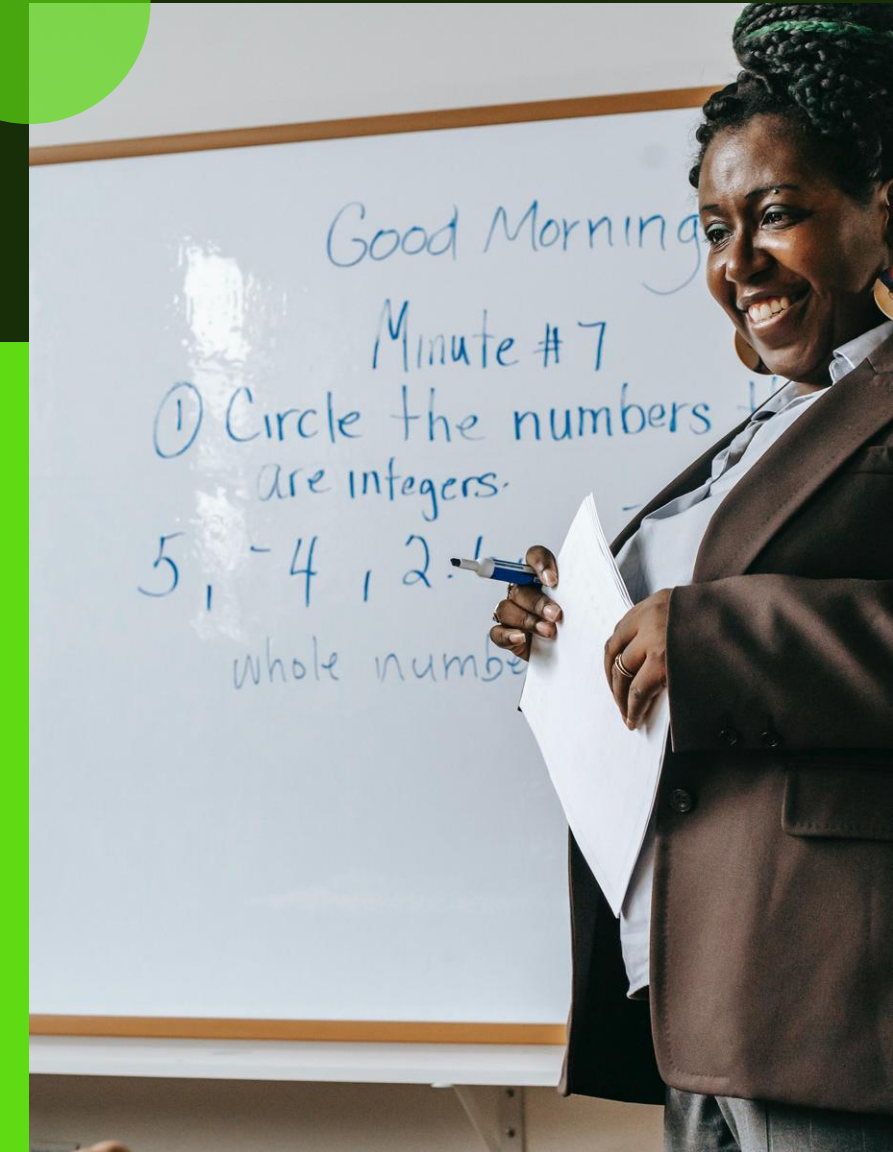

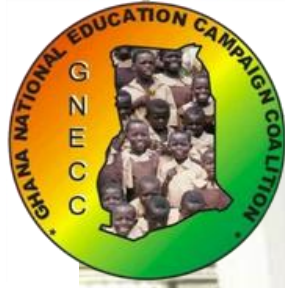
ENGAGED WITH DUTY BEARERS AND OTHER STAKEHOLDERS

GNECC GREATER ACCRA ENGAGED WITH DUTY BEARERS AND OTHER STAKEHOLDERS

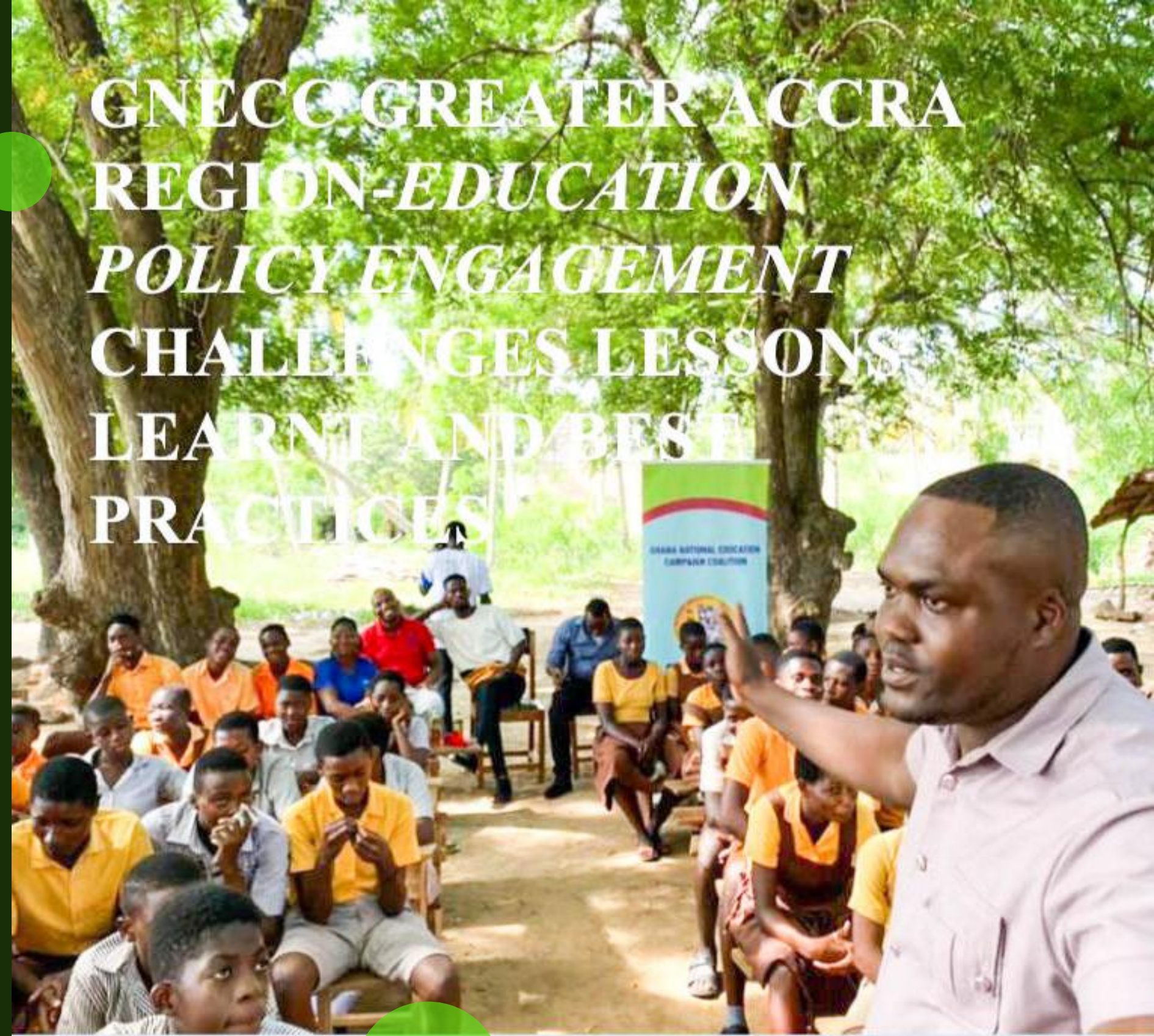

GNECC GAR Participated in a radio discussion on Teacher Licensure exams failure, a worrying trend on Original TV.

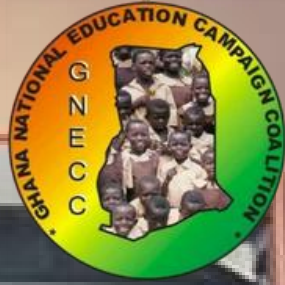

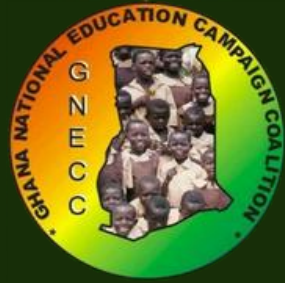

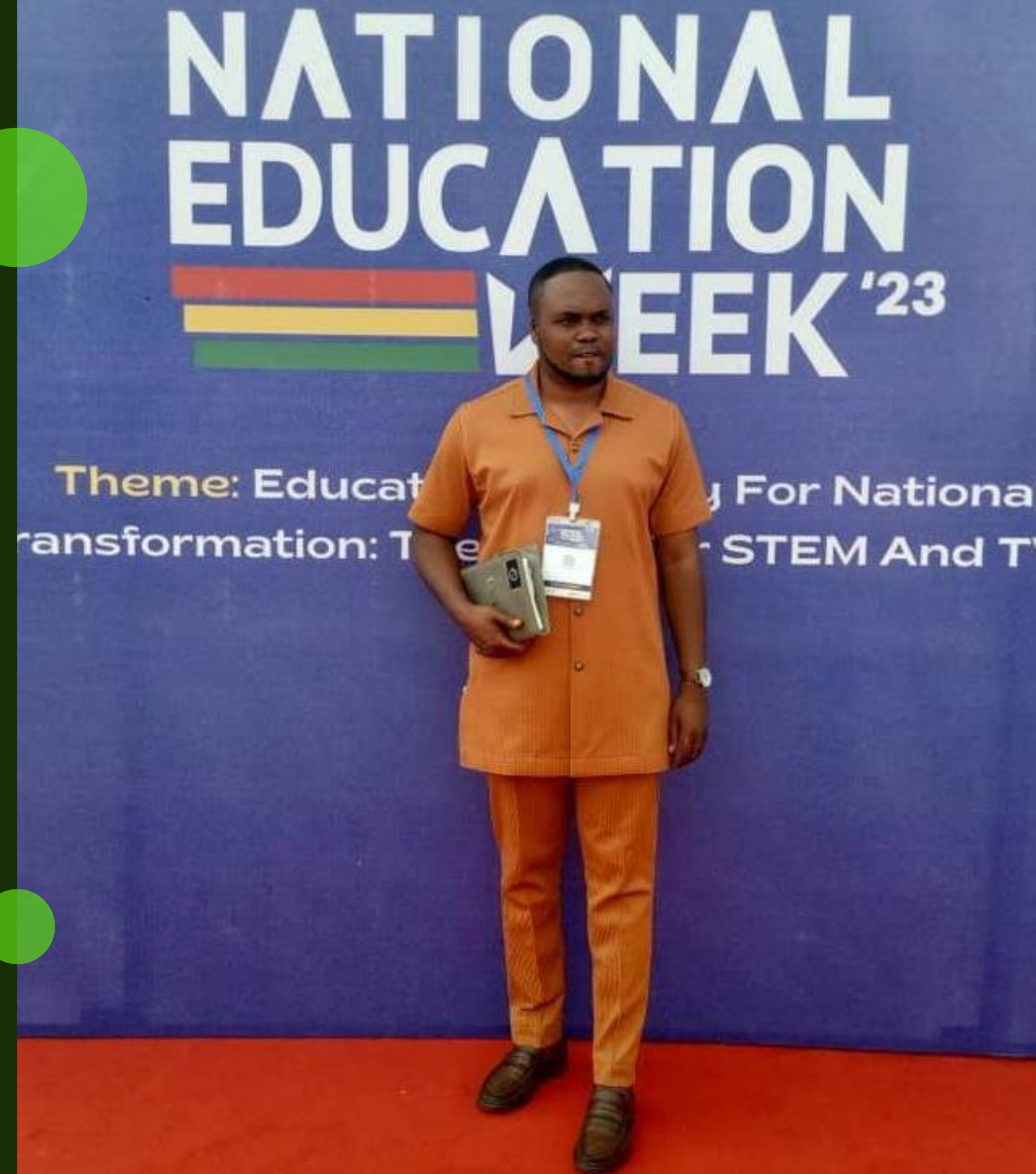

IMPACT

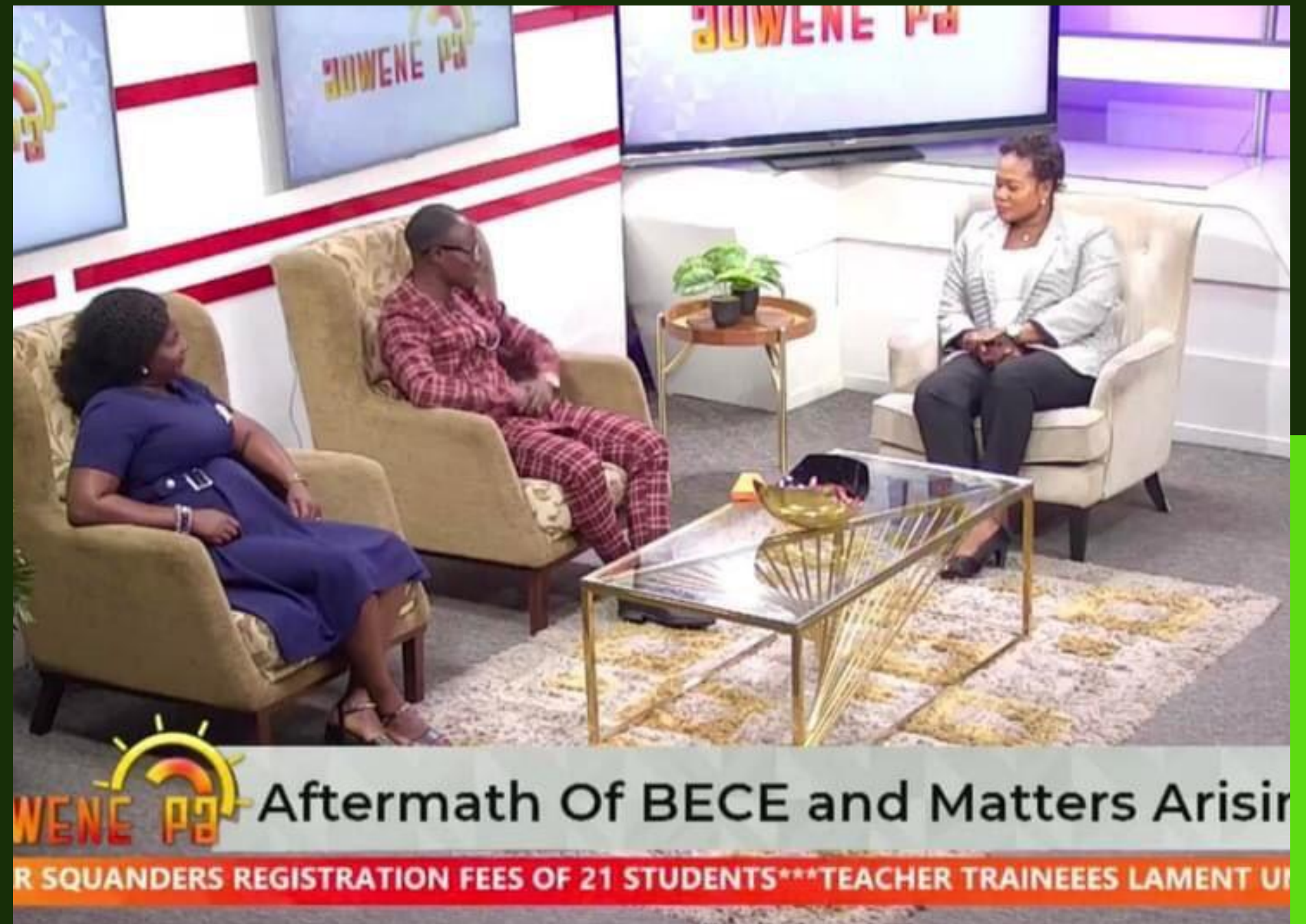
We actively engaged and built the capacities of over 20 DEFATS in 4 working Districts /Municipal in the Greater Accra Region on Educational issues.

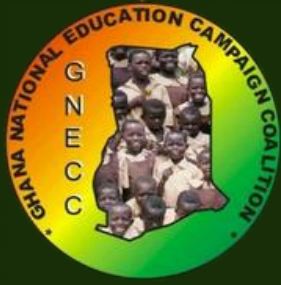
GNECC GAR have revamped the cordial working relationship with 5 Districts Assemblies in 2023 working actively together to promote inclusive and equitable education for all.

CHALLENGES

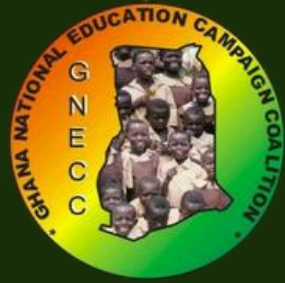
We are facing some communication challenges which we are working on together with national Secretariat.

Since most organizations in Accra support National Secretariat, it makes it difficult for GNECC GAR to get funding from most organization even with our fundraising drive to most of these organizations

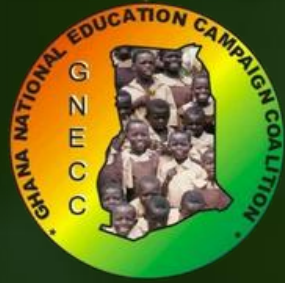




WAY FORWARD
